### Fuzhifangzhou Voluntary Teaching Programs,2019

Program Date: From July 6th (arrival in Beijing) to July 23<sup>th</sup>

Venue: Beijing City, Shangdong Province, Henan Province, etc.

#### 1. Program Description:

Voluntary Teaching Program will start from July 6<sup>th</sup> and finish on July 23<sup>th</sup>, participants arrive in Beijing on July 6<sup>th</sup>, and be trained at Tsinghua University from July 7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, then set off to teaching location on July 9<sup>th</sup>. Students of the same groups can teach English and/or provide culture talks and intercultural communication exercises to primary school pupils or middle school students in remote areas in China. International volunteers are supposed to prepare teaching plans and materials such as English movies, stories, pictures and etc. or prepare talks to introduce their countries, hometowns and universities to expand the locals' horizon of the world.



#### 2. Language & Proficiency Requirement:

English. No Chinese language requirement.

#### 3. Required Experience:

None. but ideal candidates will have experience or interest in Chinese history and culture as well as rural issues or development issues, have experience living in rural areas and/or experience in diverse cross-cultural settings.

#### 4. Major Requirement:

None, but preferred candidates are those with stated or intended academic interests in history or liberal arts or Asian studies and/or languages and/or voluntary work or social work.

**5. Student Minimum Age:**

18 years old

**6.Registration Fee:**

Participants are responsible for payment of the following items: a *non-refundable* registration fee **\$500** in US dollar,round-trip air travel to and from Beijing, visa fees, and appropriate health insurance for the duration of the program. Participants need to wire the registration fee to Tsinghua University account before June 10<sup>th</sup>,2019.

**7.Housing & Lodging Information:**

Tsinghua University and Tseng Hin Pei Charity Fund will provide accommodation, meals and transportation for Oxford participants during the programs in China. Accommodation would be basic, i.e. typical Chinese student dormitories and student canteens. Bedding, mosquito netting, and other basic necessities will be provided.

**8.Certificate**

Participants who complete the programs and submit the reflection are eligible to receive a certificate issued by Tsinghua University.
